I am requesting funding for Multi Craft Core Curriculum Expansion in fiscal year 2023.

The entity to receive funding for this project is the Colorado Building and Construction Trades Council located at 4704 Harlan St. Suite 220 Denver CO 80212.

The funding would be used for workforce training and career planning for underserved communities, high schools, and re-entry ensures everyone has access to tools to lift themselves up with a good-paying career in construction. This project would expand existing, successful Multi Craft Core Curriculum through the hiring of new teachers and navigators to support students being prepared for and getting into Union Apprenticeship Programs.
