I am requesting funding for the Federal Parkway Multimodal Transportation Improvements project in the upcoming surface transportation reauthorization legislation.

The project sponsor for this project is the City of Westminster and the project is located at Federal Parkway from 120<sup>th</sup> Avenue to 122<sup>nd</sup> Avenue, Westminster, CO 80234.

The funding is designated for construction of roadway improvements and bike lanes to Federal Parkway. This project will complete the installation of multimodal improvements to create a consistent roadway section along Federal Parkway from West 120th Avenue to West 122nd Avenue, including asphalt pavement overlay, a concrete median, bike lanes, improved drainage, an enhanced connection to the Big Dry Creek Trail and energy efficient LED street lighting.

The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer dollars and would improve safety and connectivity between existing and growing communities to a north/south highway (SH 287) and an east/west highway (SH 128). Greater connectivity will increase the productivity and competitiveness of the local and regional community including a connection to a safe pedestrian crossing of a major arterial road for people to enjoy the regional Big Dry Creek Trail and open space, and new bicycle facilities.
